

Declaration of Conformity – REACH and RoHS 2026-04-23

Regulation (EC) No. 1907/2006 (REACH) and Directive 2011/65/EU (as amended by Directive (EU) 2017/2102 and delegated amendments, including 2015/863/EU (RoHS)) define substance restrictions for products placed on the European market.

RoHS Compliance

Trenz Electronic GmbH confirms that products supplied comply with the requirements of RoHS Directive 2011/65/EU in its current version. The following exemptions according to Annex III and IV of the RoHS Directive may be applied depending on product configuration:

- 7(c)-I: Lead in glass or ceramic of electronic components
- 15a: Lead in solders for flip-chip semiconductor packages (renewal process ongoing)

Not all exemptions apply to all products. Exemptions are used only where technically necessary and legally permitted.

REACH Compliance

Based on our current knowledge and supplier declarations, products may contain substances from the REACH Candidate List of Substances of Very High Concern (SVHC, version of February 4, 2026).

Known SVHC in our product portfolio:

- Lead (CAS 7439-92-1) in electronic components, solders, ceramics, glass

All supplied articles comply with the restrictions set out in Annex XVII of the REACH Regulation. For articles supplied by us, there is no authorization-requiring use of substances from the REACH Authorization List (Annex XIV) (see ECHA Authorisation List).

This statement is based on information from our suppliers. No analytical testing is performed. Conformity assurance is part of our supplier qualification.

We confirm that this declaration refers to the versions of the REACH and RoHS regulations valid on the above date.
